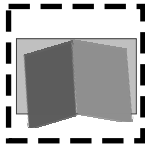

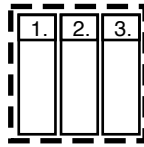
Flip Book Foldable Dictionary

Fold your own mini dictionary. Write as many vocabulary terms as you can, then define each word and try to use them in a sentence!



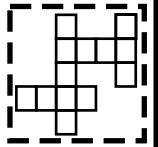
Sort It!

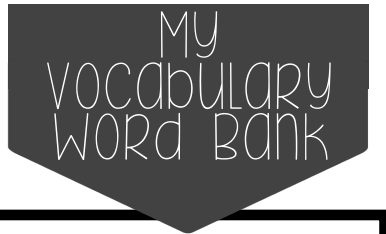
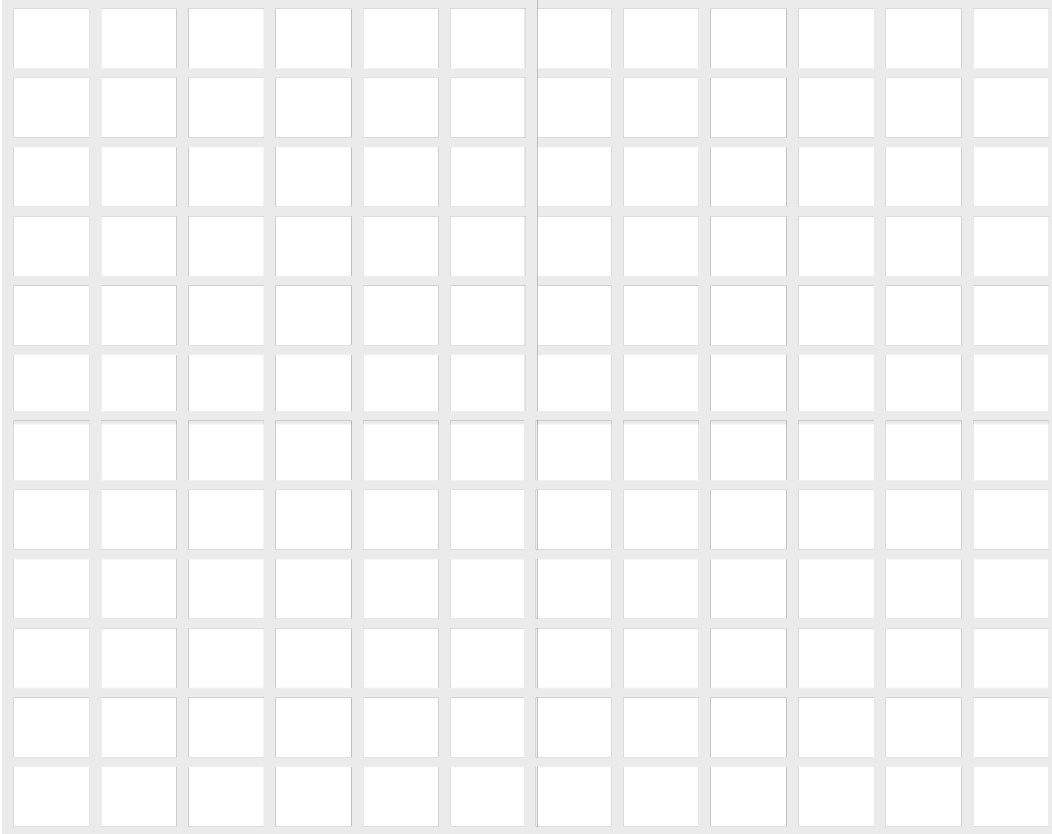
